Installation Guide

Version 2.16 and higher

Introduction

This version of installation guide is valid for these versions of application SecureStore 2.16 and next Versions (higher).

Installation packages are prepared in accordance with version of Windows.

For the operating system Windows 32bit: **securestore_2_16_csob_x86.zip**

For the operating system Windows 64bit: **securestore_2_16_csob_x64.zip**

Use the installation packages, which corresponds to the version of your Windows.

You must be logged into the computer as a user with administrator permissions.

Uninstall the older version of application SecureStore before you start the installation.

Installing I.CA Securestore

Installing Securestore I.CA covers the Client Application and a set of libraries, in particular the PKCS11 and CSP libraries and runtime for Java.

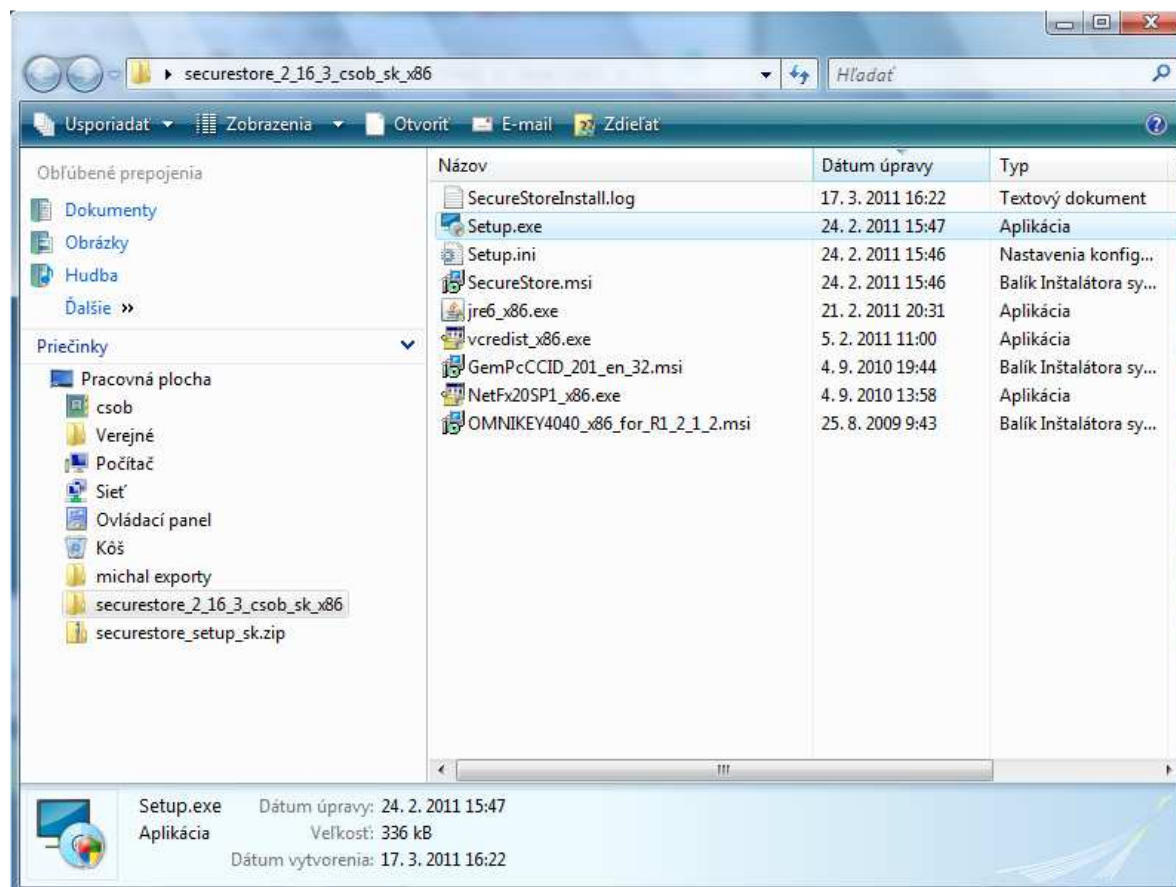
Screenshots are made for operating system Windows 7 32bit.

Installation procedure for other version of operating system Windows, or another PC, where it is not yet installed Java runtimes may be a little different from the example below.

Download installation package from the official website of [ČSOB](#).

Extract all the files on disc.

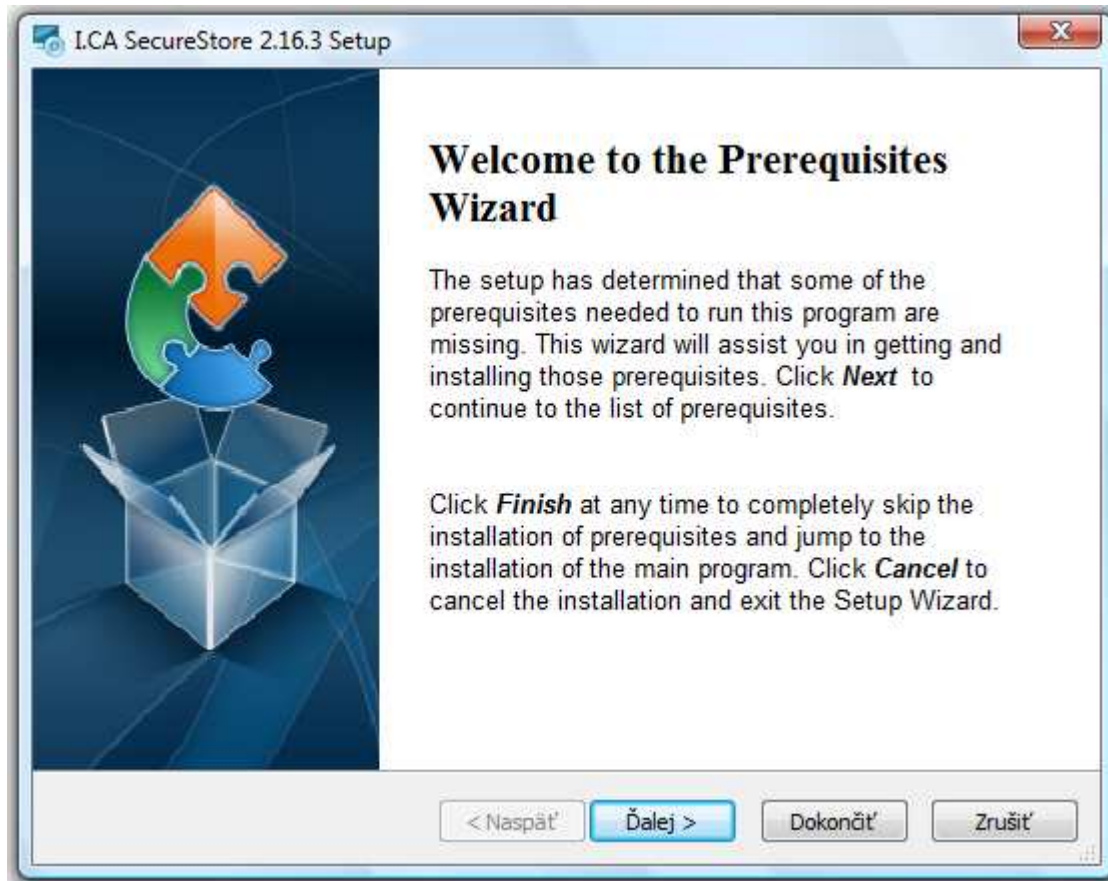
Installation is launched using the file **setup.exe**.



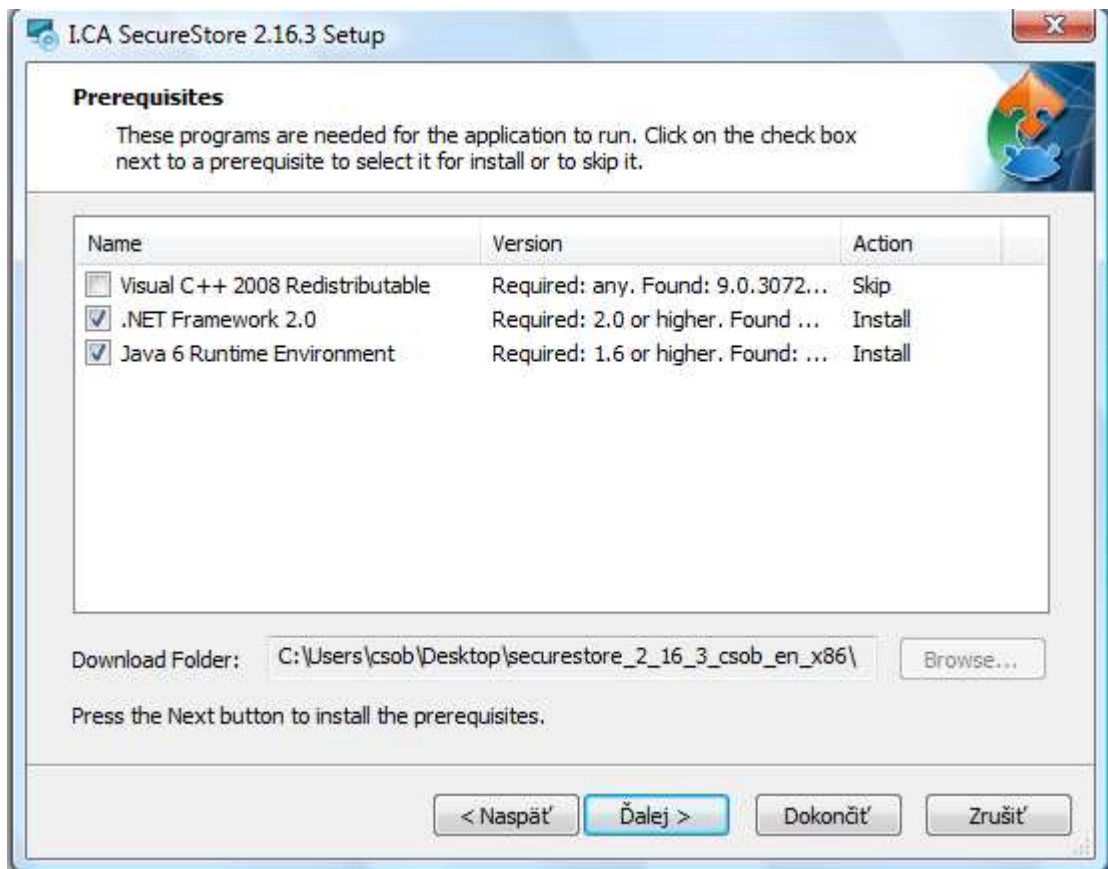
The installation process depends on other programs and set of libraries installed on your PC. Unless on your PC have not been installed sets of libraries JRE – Java runtime environment and .NET Framework, these sets of libraries will be installed in step 1 after launch setup.sk

Unless on your PC have been installed these sets of libraries, installation continues directly to the installation of SW Securestore, i.e. step 2.

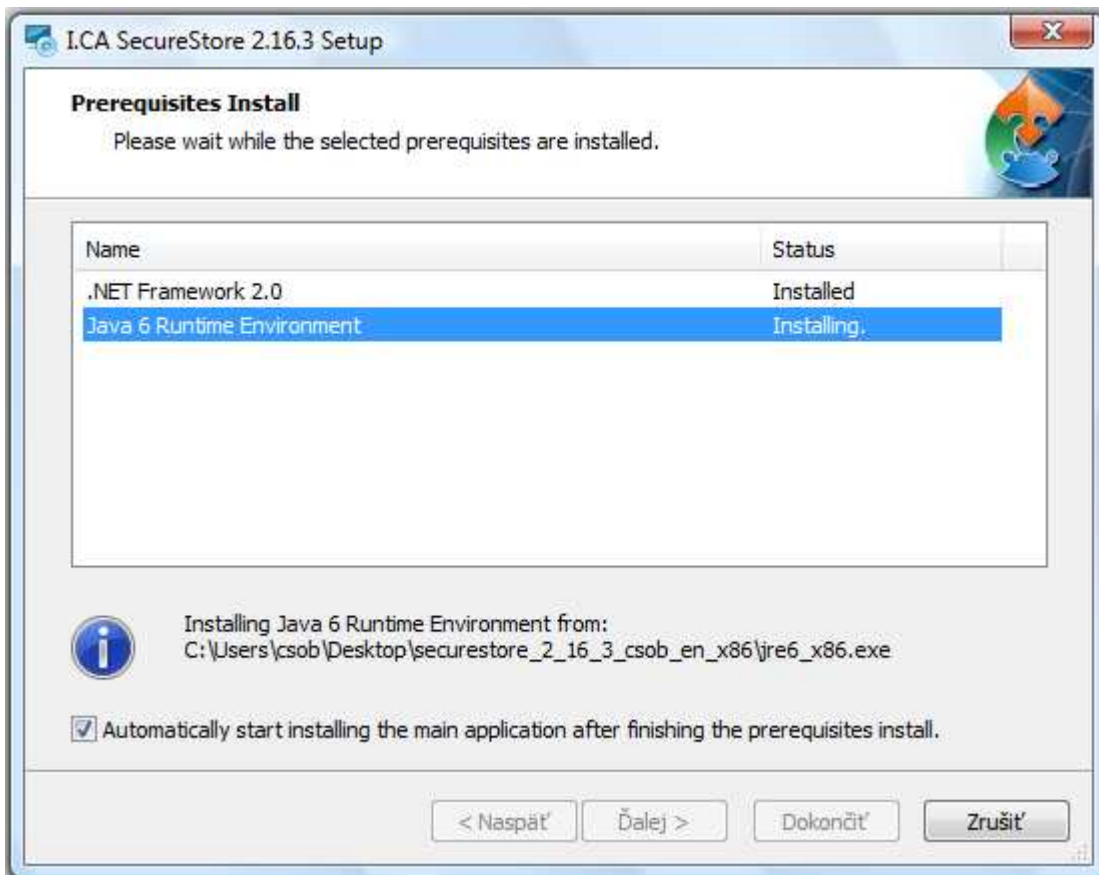
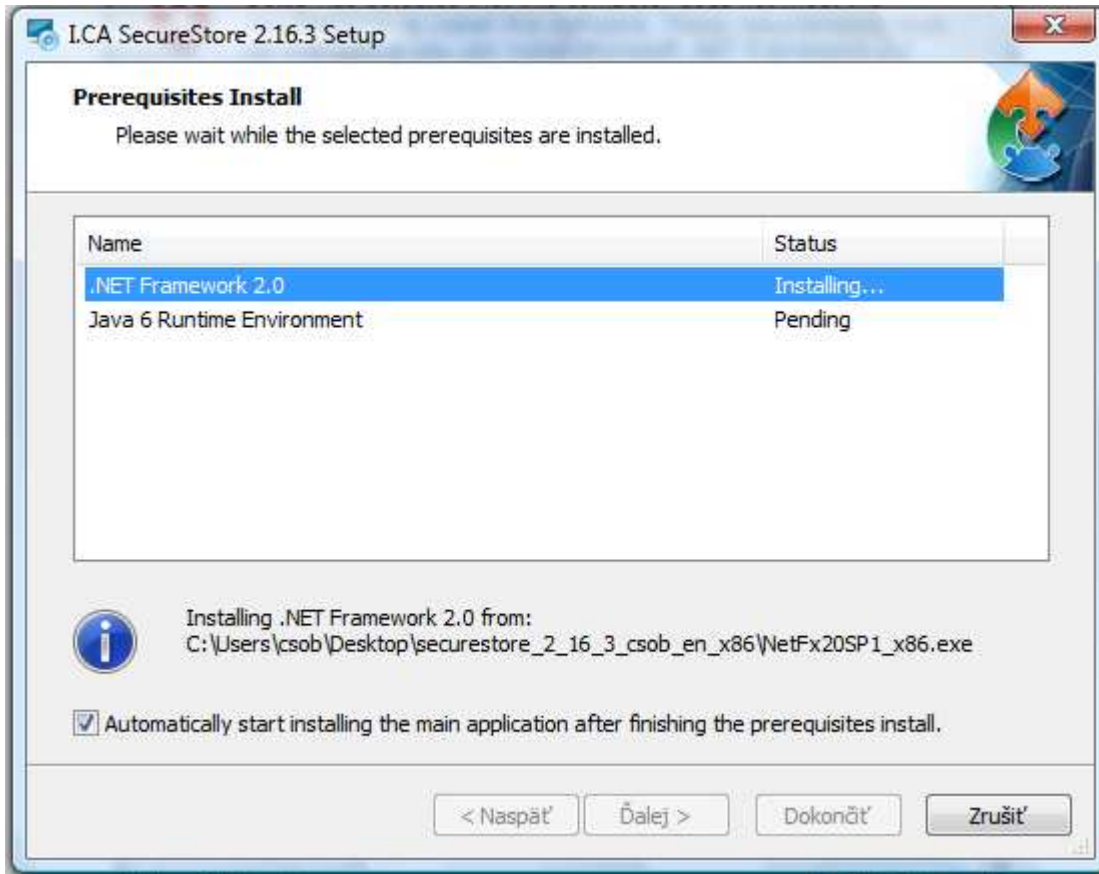
Step 1 – Installation of libraries



Press Next (Ďalej) to continue.



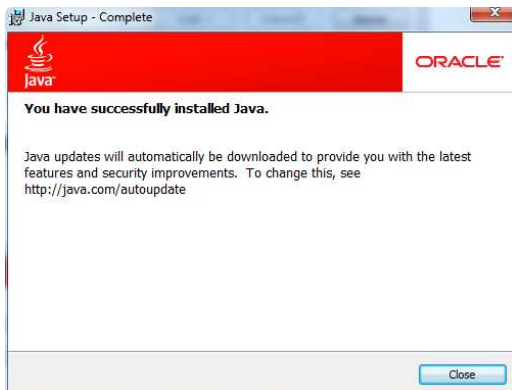
Preparatory files which need to be installed, are recognized automatically. It is not necessary to change this setting. Press the button Next (Dalej) to continue.



Press Install to continue.



Press the button Close to close screen.



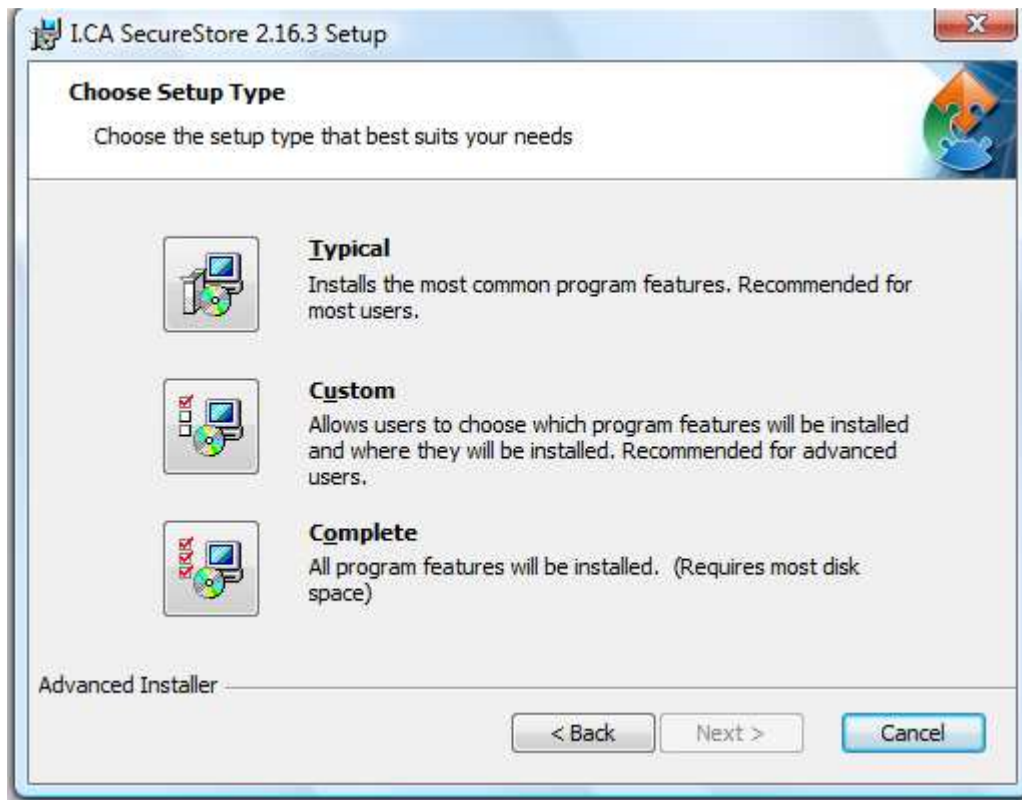
Step 2 –Installing SW I.CA SecureStore



Press Next to continue.

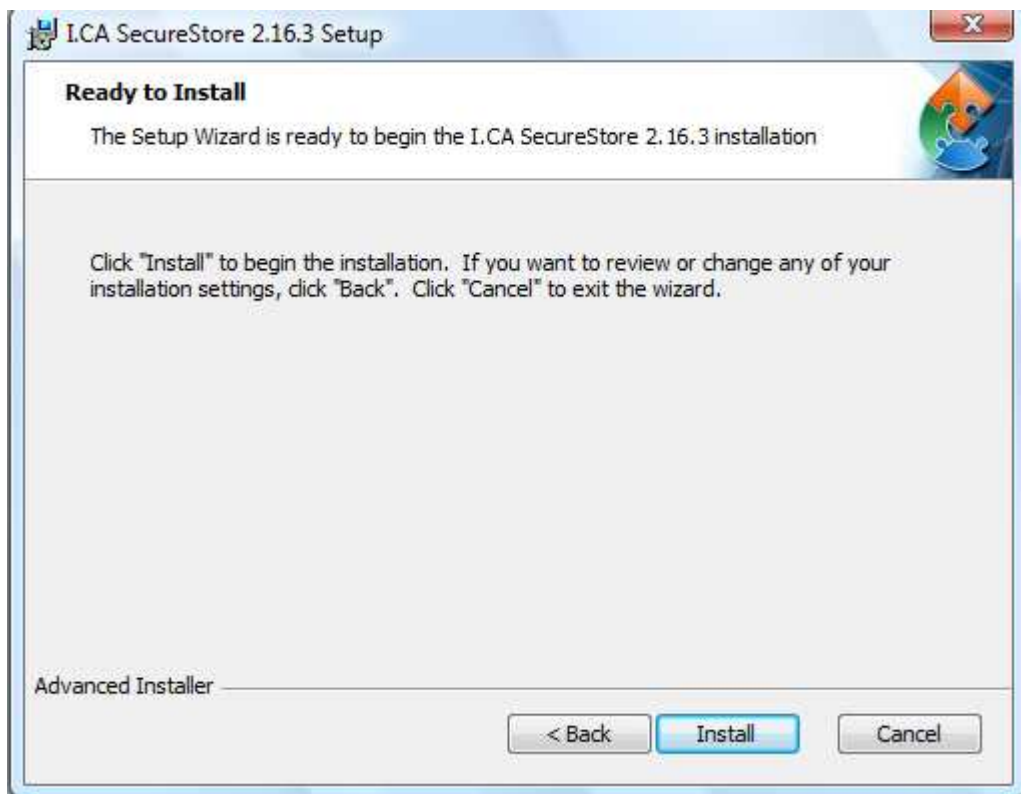
Step 3 – The choice of installation type

Choose a variant Typical and then click Next

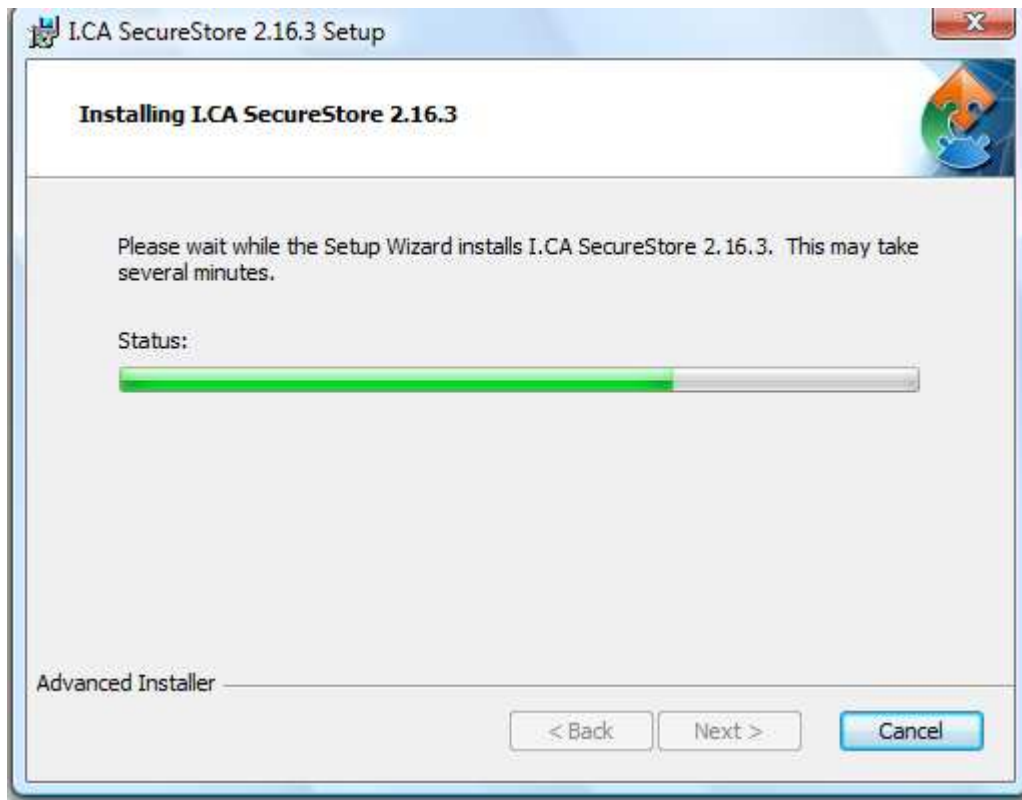


Step 4 – Installing I.CA SecureStore

Installation of the selected items into the selected location start by pressing the button Install.

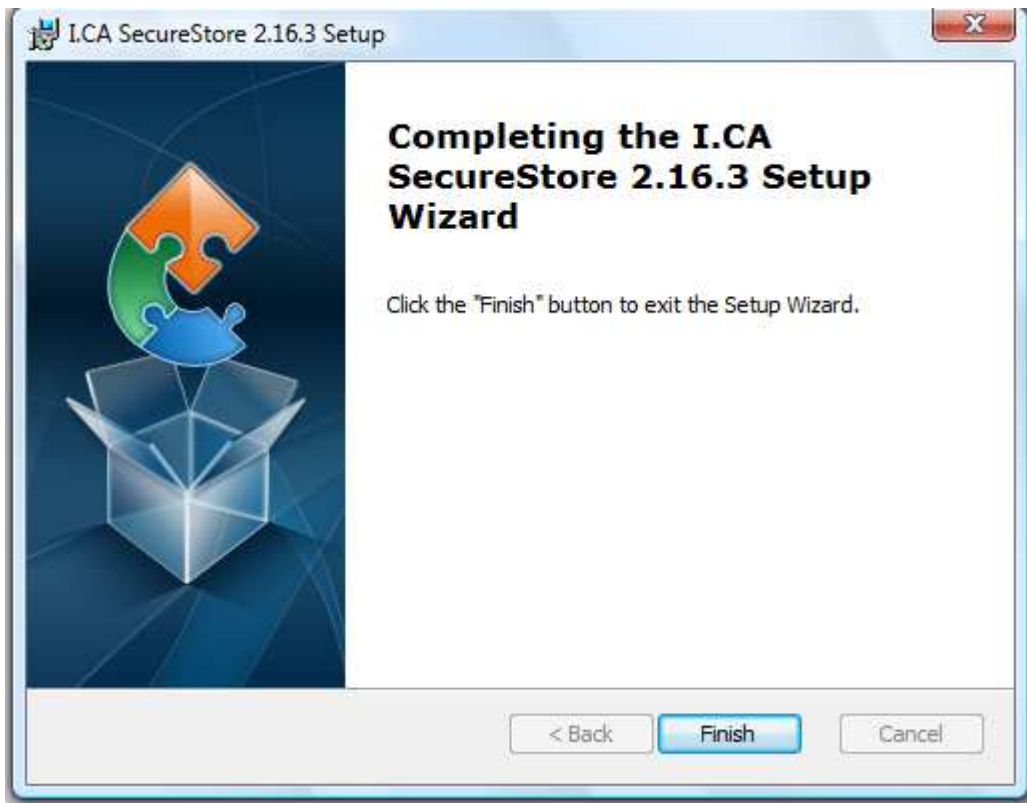


Step 5 – I.CA SecureStore installation proces



If you selected in step 3 Typical installation or Custom installation with driver of any chip card reader, the driver for that reader will be installed – see below. If you did not select any chip card reader or the drivers for a chip card reader were detected, the installation will continue to the final screen.

Step 6 - Complete the installation



After installation has finished a window will appear with confirmation. Press the Finish button to complete the installation process.
Connect your chip card reader to your PC before launching Securestore.

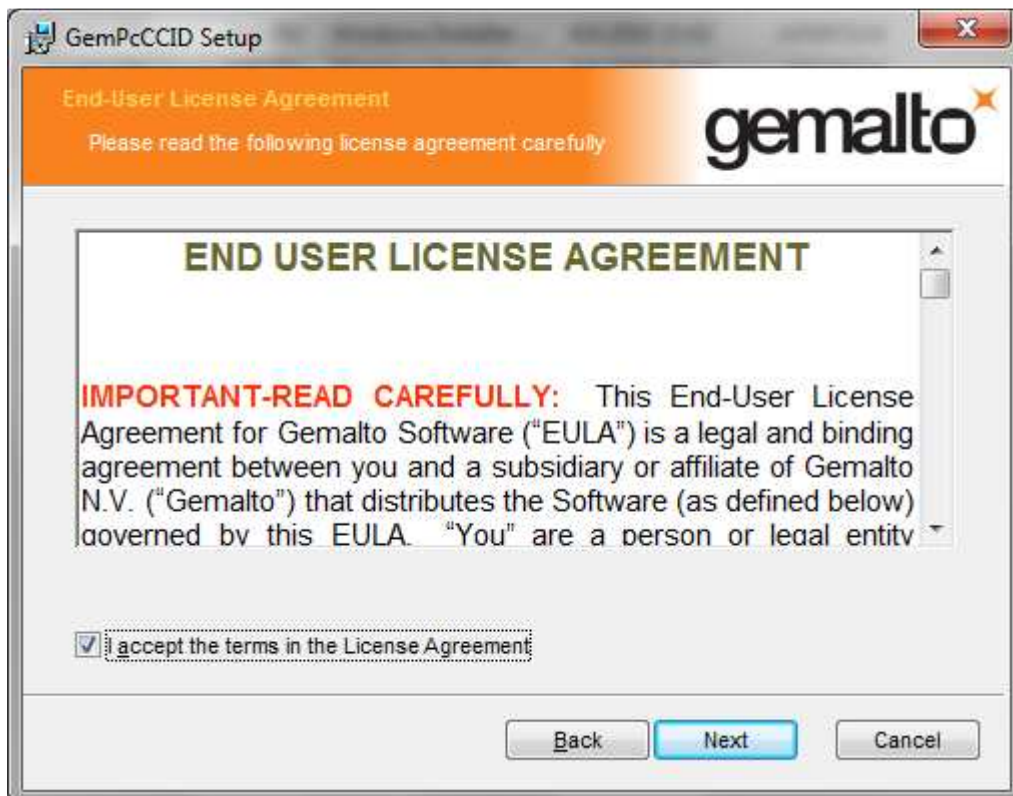
Installing the driver for the reader

If you selected a reader during the installation process, the driver for that reader will be installed between steps 5 and 6. The following example shows the steps to install the driver for the GEMPC Twin/USB-SL reader.

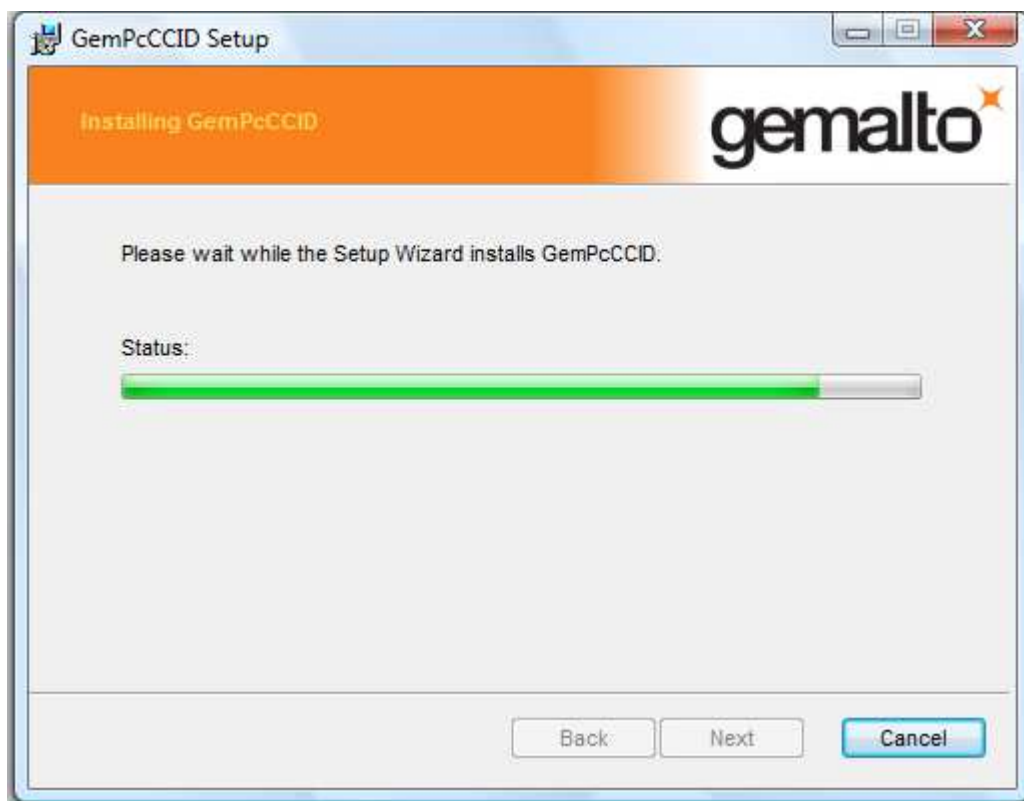

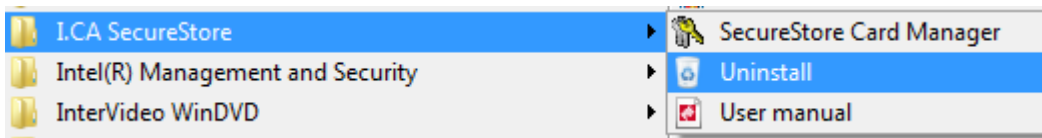
Uninstalling I.CA SecureStore

Always uninstall Securestore I.CA before installing a new version of the software
Recommended uninstall procedure:

1. Remove the card from the reader
2. Restart Windows
3. Uninstall the software in the following way

You can then install the new version of SW I.CA Securestore.

Uninstall I.CA Securestore using the Start menu – All programs – I.CA SecureStore - Uninstall



The choice of Uninstall will start the installation program I.CA SecureStore.

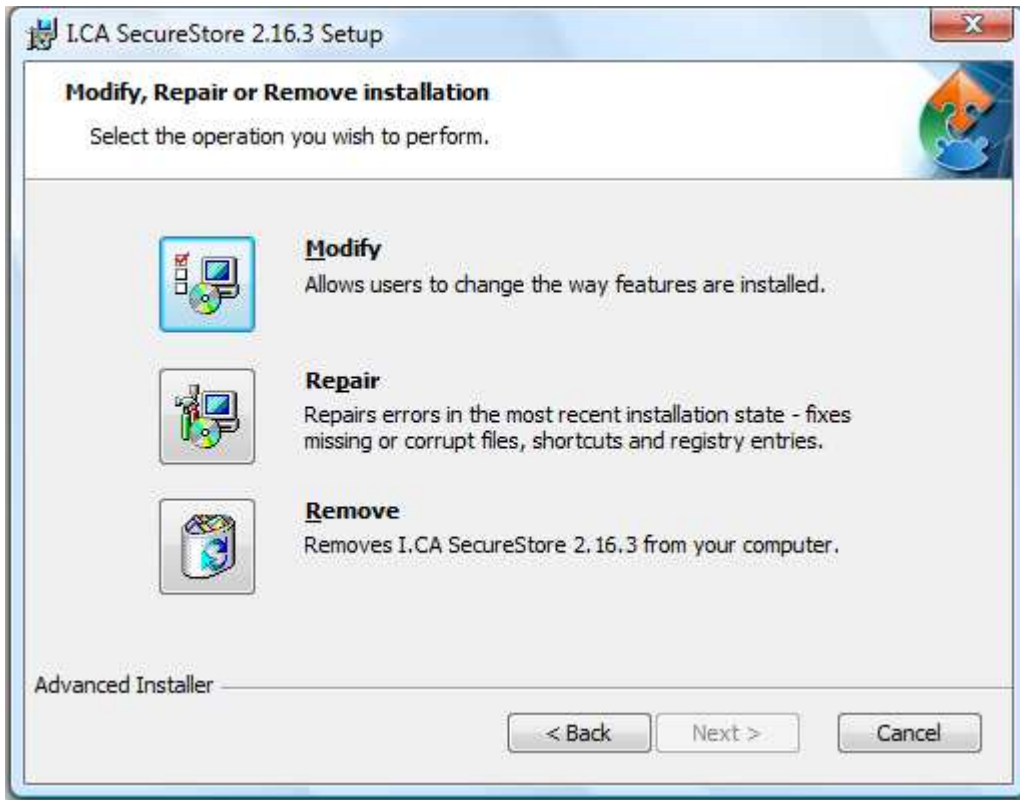
Step 1. Starting the uninstallation program



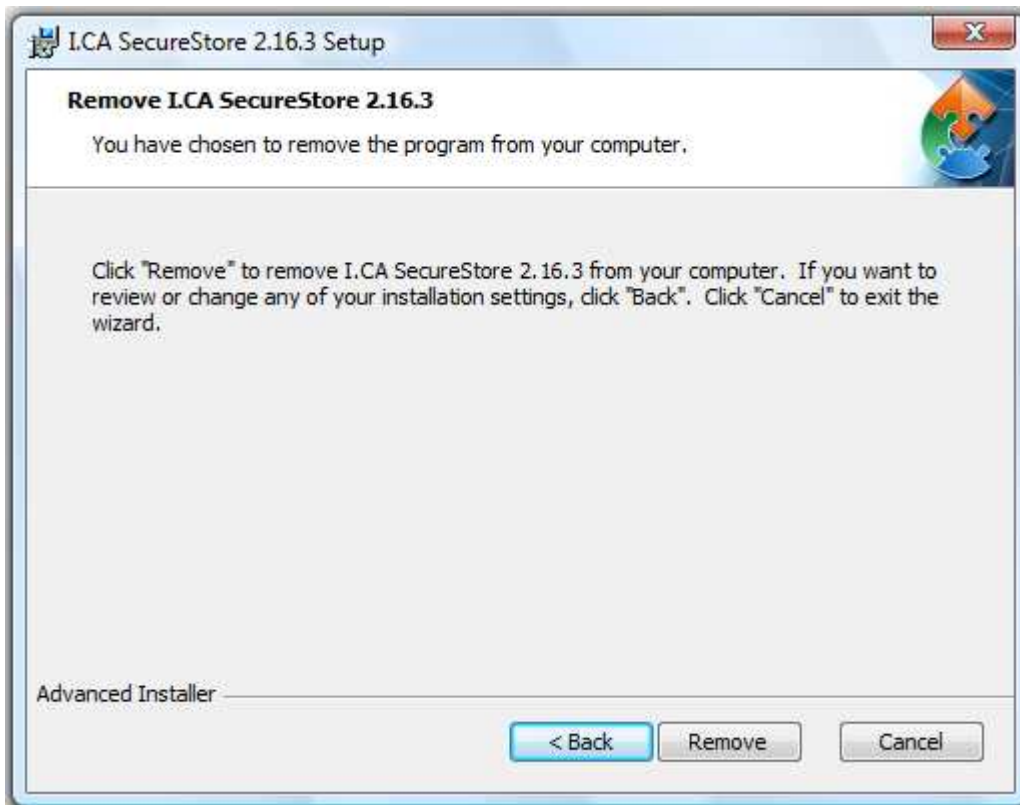
Press Next to open window. In this newly opened window choose Remove.

Step 2. The choice of operation

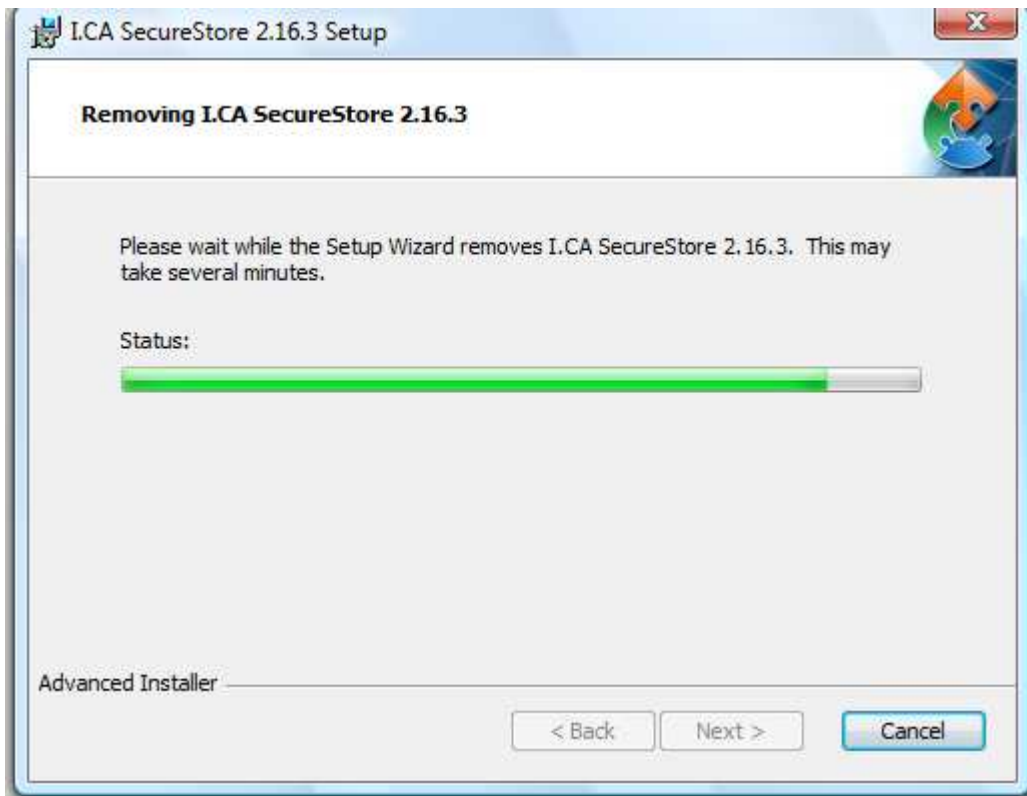
Press Remove to uninstall SW I.CA SecureStore.

Press Remove in the next window.

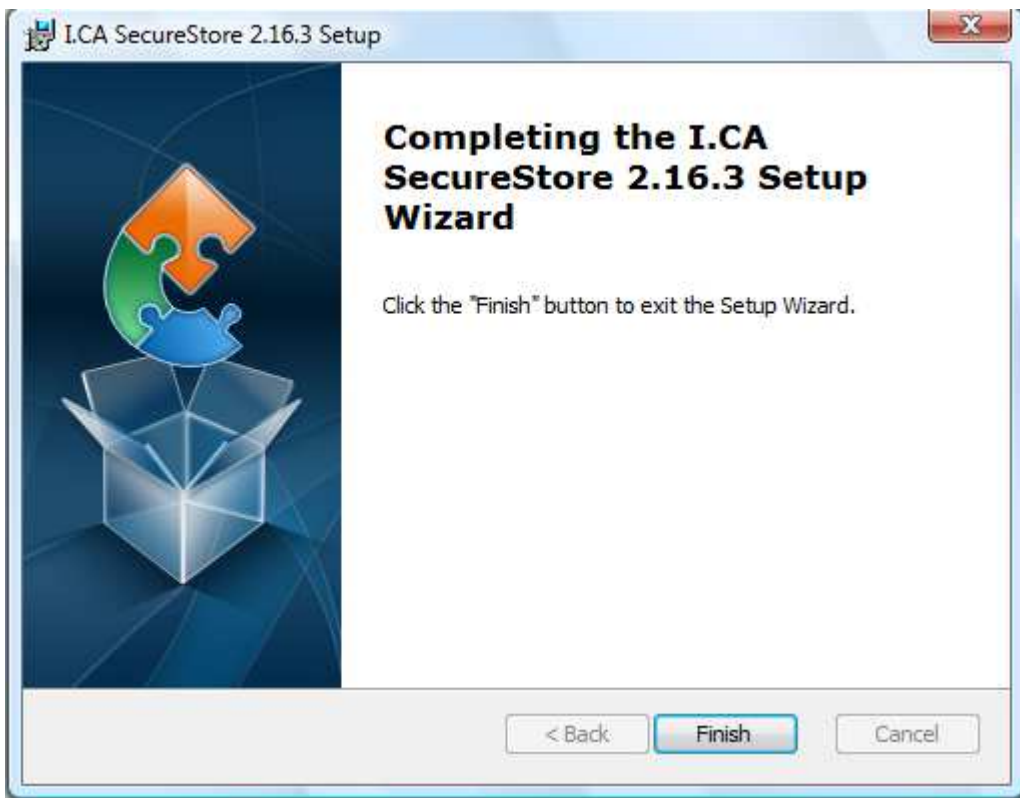


Step 4. Removing process

After uninstallation has finished a window will appear with confirmation. Press the Finish button to complete the installation process.
